Guidelines for the last Rose Herr VIM Mission Grants

Rose Herr, a long time member of Zion UMC in Wishek, ND, gifted the church through her estate for the support of foreign missions. In this final year of the disbursement of these funds, the Zion UMC decided to make two \$1,000 grants available for any VIM Mission Teams from the Dakotas Conference.

Requirements:

- 1) Funds are available in whole or part to Volunteer In Mission (VIM) Teams in the Dakotas Conference.
- 2) The VIM Team(s) must be going outside US borders to an approved General Board of Global Ministries mission site.

3) Representative(s) of the VIM Team are requested to present a personal report or testimony of the VIM trip funded, and do so during worship on a Sunday at Zion UMC in Wishek, ND.

4) Completed applications for the funds should be submitted by February 28th, 2011 to the Missions Committee at Zion UMC in Wishek.

5) Funds will be awarded in the Spring with the approval by the Church Council of Zion UMC in Wishek.
