

## Part-Time Director of Children's Ministry Job Description - Fusion Church

Fusion is a 5-year-old church that has grown to 170 people in weekly worship attendance, and is still growing. We seek to create a place where those who have never felt comfortable in a church can feel welcome, be encouraged to ask the tough questions and to be okay with doubt and faith together.

**Position Title:** Director of Children's Ministry (part time, 5-10 hours)

## Responsibilities

- Recruit, equip and support volunteers to share in all aspects of Children's Ministry
- Attend weekly staff meetings as able
- Communicate in a timely manner and as effectively as possible using all available resources
- Manage the budgets for Children's Ministry areas
- Work in concert with the gifts and talents of other staff members and maintain a teamwork mentality
- Help plan, develop, and implement all aspects of a Children's Ministry program
- · Recruit and meet regularly with an advisory team for Children's Ministry
- Select programming and coordinate volunteers for Vacation Bible School (one week each summer)
- Help plan & recruit volunteers for family oriented outreach events such as an indoor inflatables event and family movie nights
- Create a learning environment conducive to focused attention and mutual respect
- Be an advocate for children and family ministries
- Be aware of resources for developing the children's ministry programming and participate in continuing education events and training opportunities when able
- Be aware of and enforce all applicable Safe Sanctuary Guidelines as established by the Fusion Church Lead Team
- Establish and maintain an effective secure checkin process for Sunday morning Children's Ministry

- A life growing in all aspects of the fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control)
