 - Medication List** (if needed)
- ▶ We also ask that your camp balance be paid-in-full before you arrive.

When You Arrive At Camp

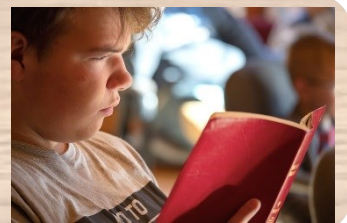
- ▶ Bring your forms to the Welcome Center.
