I'm coming to camp! Now what?

For kids and their special adult: Come for this two-day camp and experience the traditional elements of camp in a faith-filled environment. There will be activities together and some when adults are free to take time for themselves.

Take in the adventure of camp by splashing in our outdoor pool, paddling across the water in a canoe, joining the excitement of a game of Gaga Ball or 4-Square, or singing around a campfire. This camp is the opportunity to let your camper go and grow, while still

supporting them at times throughout the day.

Two Weeks Before Camp - Full payment for camp is due. And be sure your **Liability Waiver & Public Relations Release** and **Medical Information/Health Form** have been filled out online. (Or bring them with you to camp - but they are **required** to attend camp)



What happens when I get to camp?

- ▶ Please park in the designated parking area at the top of camp
- ▶ Bring forms, medications, and camp store money to the Welcome Center in the camp office located inside Harmony Cabin.
- ▶ Bring, or have completed on-line, your two forms for each person:
 - **Medical Information/Health**
 - **Release of Liability Waiver & Public Relations Release**
- ▶ There will be a short health screening and you will have time to meet with our health care manager and go over your Health Form.
- ▶ Adults are expected to be in charge of all medications for their families/campers and medications must be locked up at all times, either in your vehicle or a lockbox.
 - All medication must be in original containers labeled with name and dosage.**
- ▶ On the Health Form, please make sure that you list the people authorized to pick up your child if they will be going home with someone other than the person they came with. We cannot release your camper unless that person's name is on the health form and they have a picture ID
- ▶ Camp Store money will be given to camp staff at check-in. Any unspent money will be returned at the end of camp.
- ▶ Remember, young campers are required to be supervised by their adult co-camper during check-in and throughout camp.
- ▶ Because of privacy concerns, do not share photos on social media of any campers other than your own.

Lost & Found -

please label all your belongings before you leave home and check out the lost & found box during your check-out time. At summer's end, all unclaimed items will be donated to local charities.

Camp Store & Canteen

The Canteen will be available each day for campers to purchase snacks. Money can be left at check-in for campers to have on their accounts. Money not spent will be returned at check-out. The Camp Store has jackets, sweatshirts, caps, t-shirts, souvenirs, postcards and stamps for sale during camp and after check-out.



What to Bring

- Signed Health & Waiver Forms if not completed online
- Medications needed during camp (in Rx bottle)
- Clothing for each day (rainy days too!)
- PJ's
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Bath towel & washcloth
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste
- Swimsuit, beach towel, sandals or water shoes
- Bible, notebook & pencil
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Tennis Shoes
- Sleeping bag (or bedding) & pillow
- Flashlight
- Water Bottle

What to Bring – Optional

- Money for Camp Store (turned in @ check-in)
- Camera
- Hat
- Extra batteries for flashlight and/or camera

What NOT to Bring

- Pets
- Sports Equipment or electronics
- Fireworks or lighters
- Extra food, snacks or pop
- Alcohol, tobacco, vapes, or drugs
- Weapons
- Vehicles (campers under 18)
- Cell phones – If campers bring a cell phone, they will need to leave it with a camp staff member during check-in



From I-94 east of Valley City

- Take exit 294 and turn right into Valley City.
- Turn right after Brothers III gas station onto 5th Avenue NE.
- Proceed under the Highline train bridge, over the Sheyenne River, and over the railroad tracks.
- Immediately turn left onto County Hwy 19. Stay on paved Co. Hwy 19 past Bald Hill Dam.
- Wesley Acres is 8 miles north of the dam halfway down the hill on the left side of the road.

From I-94 west of Valley City

- Take exit 283 and turn left onto ND Hwy 1.
- Proceed north for 12 miles.
- Turn right onto Co. Hwy 10 (24th Street) just as you approach the Rogers Elevator on your left.
- Proceed 5 miles east on the paved road to a T-intersection and stop sign.
- Turn left (north) onto Co. Hwy 19 and proceed on the pavement six miles.
- Wesley Acres is on your left halfway down the hill.

From north and west of camp

- Proceed south on ND Hwy 1.
- Turn left (east) just past Dazey onto ND Hwy 26.
- Proceed 6.3 miles.
- Turn right at the top of the hill onto County Hwy 19 (115th Ave SE).
- Proceed 2.4 miles to Wesley Acres on your right, just over the creek.

From north and east of camp

- Proceed south on ND Highway 32.
- Turn right (west) just past Pillsbury onto ND Hwy 26.
- Proceed 7.4 miles.
- Turn left (south) onto County Hwy 19 (115th Ave SE).
- Proceed 2.4 miles to Wesley Acres on your right, just over the creek.




Wesley Acres Camp Camp Map
