- Dates and times of your event
- Packing lists
- Contact information
- Forms required for you to attend camp

I'm coming to camp! Now what?

- ▶ First, let us begin by saying how EXCITED we are that we are going to be sharing camp with you! We can't wait to get to know you!
- ▶ These forms are required: Medical Information Form, Release of Liability Form, COVID Release of Liability Form and, if needed, a Medications Form. These forms are **REQUIRED** to attend camp and **must be signed by the participant's legal parent/guardian!** You can download and print these form found under the Download Forms tab, or request they be sent via email or US postal mail. If you registered online and filled these forms out under the Online Forms tab on your dashboard you do not need to print and bring these forms to camp.
- ▶ Online forms and payment need to be completed at least two weeks prior to camp.
- ▶ Now, all you have to do is keep looking forward to a wonderful time at camp! Look through the rest of this letter to find everything else you'll need to get ready!
- ▶ **IMPORTANT: Specific guidance around COVID-19 protocols will be provided prior to the start of your event. Please watch your email for messages from the camping office.**

What happens when I get to camp?

- ▶ Go to Harmony Cabin when you arrive at camp to check in. During check-in you'll **turn in your signed "Release of Liability"** forms (if not completed online) and meet your camp counselors.
 - ▶ You will also have time to meet with our health care manager and turn in your signed **"Medical Information"** form (if not completed online.)
- Any medications needed during camp should be given to the health care manager with the Medications Form. You will be able to ask any of your health-related questions.
- ▶ Turn in your money to spend at the Camp Store and check out the items we have for sale. The store will be open during check-in.
 - ▶ Remember, campers are required to be supervised by their parents or guardians until they are completely checked-in.





What do I need to bring?



► It's never too late to **bring a friend!** For each new camper you invite who registers and attends camp, you will receive a discount of \$25 off the cost of registration. Sharing camp with a friend makes a great experience even better!

► **Lost & Found** - please label all your belongings before you leave home and check out the lost & found box during your check-out time. At summer's end, all unclaimed items will be donated to local charities.

Packing Checklist:

- Signed Liability Forms if not completed online**
- Signed Medical Information Form if not completed online**
- Medications & form if needed during camp
- Masks: 1/day, also may purchase at camp store
- Sleeping bag (or bedding) & pillow
- Bath towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush & paste
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Bible, if you have one or use ours
- Flashlight & extra batteries
- Swimsuit, beach towel, sandals/water shoes, hat
- Clothing for each day (rainy days too!)
- Jackets & Sweatshirts
- Camera (charger, batteries, memory card)
- Tennis Shoes (or other closed-toe shoes)
- Money for Camp Store (turned in @ check-in)

What NOT to bring:

- Cell Phones** - If campers bring a cell phone, they will need to leave it with a camp staff member during check-in.
- iPod/MP3 players**
- Fireworks/Lighters**
- Extra Food/Snacks/Pop**
- Video Games/Computers**
- Alcohol/Tobacco/Drugs/Weapons/Vehicles/Animals**
- Valuable Items**



How can I contact my camper?

► **Mail** - Campers LOVE to receive mail! Please allow at least 3 days for standard mail to reach camp. Keep in mind that for shorter events, you may need to mail letters before your camper leaves home. You are also free to leave letters for your camper with a staff member during check-in to be distributed throughout the week. Notes from home will make a great experience even better!

► **Phone Calls** - campers are allowed to use the camp phones only for emergencies. If you have questions, concerns, or need to contact your child, please feel free to call the camp's phone number listed in this letter. Our staff is happy to assist you and will deliver your message to your camper as soon as possible.

► **E-Mail** - A great way to send mail and make sure it arrives on time is by e-mail. Simply **send an e-mail to WAcampers@dakcamps.org**.

In the subject line please put: Camper's Name - Camp Name. Camp staff will print e-mails daily and deliver them to your camper. Please note this is a one-way service and campers will not be able to respond.

- The health care manager will be available to **return any checked-in medications**.

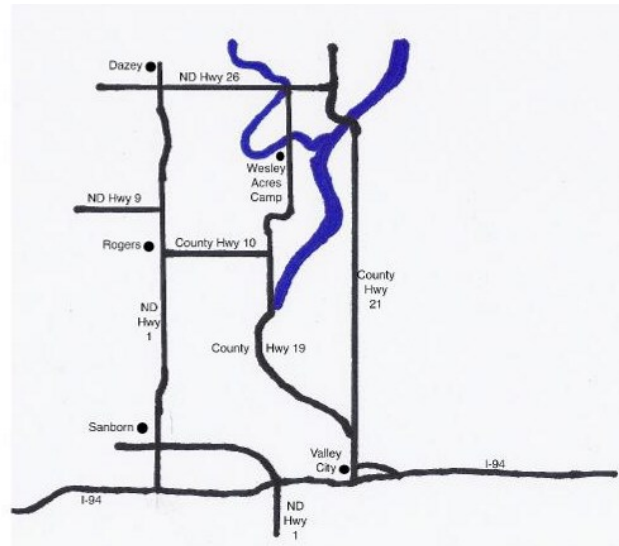

<p>From I-94 east of Valley City:</p>	<p>From I-94 west of Valley City:</p>
<p>Take exit 294 and turn right into Valley City. Turn right after Brothers III gas station onto 5th Avenue NE. Proceed under the Highline train bridge, over the Sheyenne River, over the railroad tracks. Immediately turn left onto County Hwy 19. Stay on paved Co. Hwy 19 past Bald Hill Dam. Wesley Acres is 8 miles north of the dam halfway down the hill on the left side of the road.</p>	<p>Take exit 283 and turn left onto ND Hwy 1. Proceed north for 12 miles and turn right onto Co. Hwy 10 (24th Street) just as you approach the Rogers Elevator on your left. Proceed 5 miles east on the paved road to a T-intersection and stop sign. Turn left (north) onto Co. Hwy 19 and proceed on the pavement six miles. Wesley Acres is on your left halfway down the hill.</p>
<p>From north and west of camp:</p>	<p>From north and east of camp:</p>
<p>Proceed south on ND Hwy 1. Turn left (east) just past Dazey onto ND Hwy 26. Proceed 6.3 miles and turn right at the top of the hill onto County Hwy 19 (115th Ave SE). Proceed 2.4 miles to Wesley Acres on your right, just over the creek.</p>	<p>Proceed south on ND Highway 32. Turn right (west) just past Pillsbury onto ND Hwy 26. Proceed 7.4 miles and turn left (south) onto County Hwy 19 (115th Ave SE). Proceed 2.4 miles to Wesley Acres on your right, just over the creek.</p>

Payment of Fees and Cancellation Policy:

Your balance is to be paid in full two weeks before camp starts. You can either log back into your account and pay on-line, make a payment over the phone to the camping office, or mail a check to camping office. Camping office information is below. **Please do not bring payments to the camp.**

Cancellation Policy:

If the camping office needs to cancel a camp, you will be notified and receive a full refund. If a camper needs to cancel, we will provide a full refund in the event of illness, COVID-19 exposure, or a family emergency. Please let us know as soon as possible if you need to request a refund. All camper cancellations must be received in writing at info@dakcamps.org

During Summer 2022, we will provide a full refund for a cancellation for any reason up to two weeks before the start of the event.

- Between 8-14 days prior to the start of camp, we will give a full refund minus a \$100 processing fee.
- Less than 7 days prior to the start of camp, no refund will be issued.
- A no call/no show to camp will result in forfeit of all payments.
