

## What to Bring to Mission u—Southern Site

We're excited you're planning to join us at Mission u—Southern Site!

Here are some things you'll want to bring or wear:

- Casual and comfortable clothes and shoes. Light sweater/jacket for air-conditioned rooms or cooler outdoor weather.
- A Bible

## DWU Bookstore and Archives will be open during registration!

The Dakota Wesleyan Bookstore housed in the McGovern Library on campus will be open during Mission u registration from 2-4 p.m. on Friday, July 14. There will be a 20% discount on clothing and a \$1 book table.

Perhaps even more exciting, during that same time (2-4 p.m. Friday, July 14), the DWU Archives will be open to Mission u participants. Housed in the McGovern Library, you can look over two archives: the Dakota Wesleyan University Archives and the Archives of the Dakotas Conference of The United Methodist Church.

The DWU Archives includes historical material about DWU, as well as the Senator Francis H. Case Collection, the Senator George McGovern Collection, and the Leonard Jennewein Collection of South Dakota and regional history.

The Archives of the Dakotas Conference of The United Methodist Church includes historical material about the churches in North Dakota and South Dakota that are part of our United Methodist heritage. This includes Methodist Episcopal, Methodist, Evangelical Association, United Brethren, and Evangelical United Brethren churches in both states. Records about the conferences, churches, and their people, including clergy, and from closed churches are among the materials in the Dakotas Conference Archives.
