

In the welcome area, they plan to add a connections desk, as well as a coffee bar. In the worship space, chairs need to be purchased and technology needs to be installed.

The new Celebrate Grace and Legacy South church building will create a warm and open atmosphere for both groups to welcome people with radical hospitality. As the people walk through the door, whether they are people in recovery, families looking for a new place of worship, or someone just looking for connection, all will be welcomed into a place where they can truly find the heart of God. This new space will be ready to provide ministry to our neighbors in need of a safe place when we are once again able to gather together to receive the Good News and grace of Jesus Christ.
