Interim Dean's Letter

October 16, 2018



This is a current day update on the planning for next Summer's trip to Kansas City with Urban Plunge and to attend Youth 2109.

Dates: July 7 to July 14.

Tentative travel plans have buses leaving from several places around the conference, and not gathering together until Kansas City. We have intentionally left July 6 open in case we need to make different travel arrangements for those in the western side of the Conference. Those details should be firmed up as we sign a bus contract.

We will be staying in the dorms of the University of Missouri-Kansas City. The rooms are primarily 2 person sleeping rooms joined by a shared bathroom. Single, dorm length beds, bring your own linens and towels. The plan is that you will know your roommate, but share a suite with two new friends.

Our hope and plan is to include all meals in your costs. In order to do this, we will be seeking donors or ministries willing to sponsor our meal times. Our mealtime estimates are from \$1625 to \$3000, depending on the meal. There will be more detailed information on those sponsorship opportunities.

Cost of the Trip: \$800. This is a price inclusive of travel and meals (with the exception of meals on the two travel days.) This price assumes we will be able to find sponsors for the meals during our time in Kansas City.

On this trip, we have traditionally included a day at an amusement or water park. That is our intent on this trip as well, but final details remain due to the question of funding and overall trip costs.

Urban Plunge is our partner for our three days of mission activity. We will be transported in our large buses to ministry sites throughout the Kansas City area. We will be in ministry with a variety of communities, doing a number of different activities. More on this as their planning program progresses.
