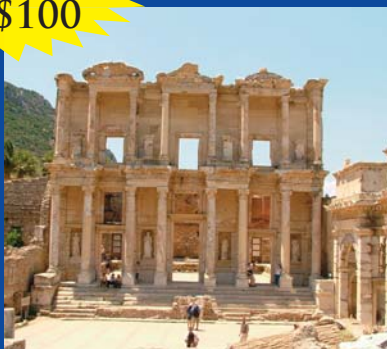

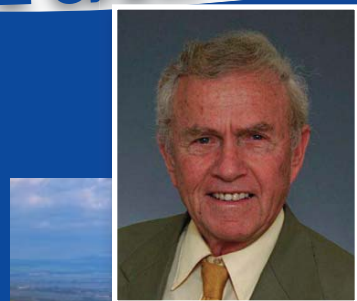

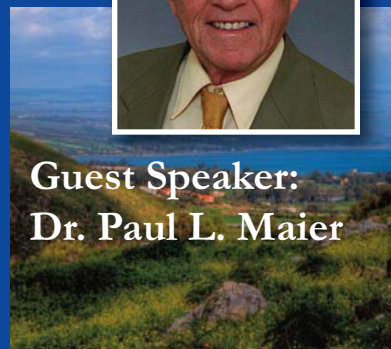

Lands of the Bible Cruise

October 3 & 4 USA Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA and arrive in Rome. Time permitting, take a panoramic tour of the Eternal City before embarking on the luxurious *Celebrity Silhouette*.

October 5 & 6 At Sea - Morning & Evening Lectures

October 7 Alexandria, Egypt Dock in **Alexandria**, founded in 331 B.C. by Alexander the Great. Alexandria is home to the **Ancient Library, lighthouse, and Pompey's Pillar**. Feel free to visit the **catacombs** or enjoy time to explore the **old city**. (Excursion own.)

October 8 Cairo, Egypt Travel to **Cairo**, Egypt's capital city meaning "The Triumphant". Cairo is the most populated metropolitan area in Africa. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza**, the last remaining ancient wonder, built before Moses and the Israelites were even in this ancient land. Also visit the **Egypt Museum**, which houses the King Tut treasures and many other artifacts from Egypt's long history.

October 9 & 10 Bethlehem & Jerusalem, Israel Travel to **Bethlehem** where you'll visit the cave revered as the place where Jesus was born (Matt. 1: 18 - 25; Luke 2: 1- 7). The church, which was constructed on the site, is the world's oldest functioning church. Go to **Jerusalem** and visit the **Upper Room**, the traditional site of the Last Supper. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas**, where Jesus was tried before the Sanhedrin. Stand upon the **Mount of Olives** and view the city as Jesus did. Wander among the olive trees of the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Enter the **Old City** and visit the **Pool of Bethesda**. You'll walk along the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher, site of the Crucifixion**.

October 11 Galilee, Israel Travel inland to the **Sea of Galilee**. You'll stand on the **Mount of the Beatitudes** where Jesus gave his most well-known sermon (Matthew 5 - 7). At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17). Visit the **Chapel of the Primacy** where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Travel to the shore town of **Capernaum** where Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, John (Matt 4:13) and later Matthew. Stop by the **River Jordan** where those who wish to be baptized may do so.

October 12 At Sea - Morning & Evening Lectures

October 13 Ephesus, Turkey Journey to **Ephesus**, the marble city where Paul spent three years of his ministry. The ruins of Ephesus have been restored much like the city was in Paul's time. You will visit the ancient **Agora** and view the **Great Theater**.

October 14 Corinth & Athens, Greece Travel to **Corinth** (Acts 18: 1-18), a city that inspired St. Paul's most familiar letters. You will visit the **Archaeological Museum, the Market Place, and Temples**. Walk among the ruins and stand before the **Bema** where Paul stood. Read Acts 18 and visualize his address to the Gentiles as he began the task of building Corinth's church. Next, the architectural splendors of the ancient city of **Athens** are as magical as ever. View the world-renowned **Acropolis, the Propylaea, and the Parthenon**. View **Mars Hill** where Paul debated with the intellectual community of his day. Walk among the ruins of the **Agora**, the ancient market place and center of Athenian public life. You will view the **Olympic Stadium, home of the Olympics**.

October 15 At Sea - Morning & Evening Lectures

October 16 Messina, Sicily Explore **Messina**, a city rich in history, and the "connecting point" with the Italian Boot. Travel to the mountainside village of **Taormina**. Climb to the top of the mountain to the Greek Theater with its spectacular view of the Mediterranean beyond. Pass through the quaint village, where stars have stayed and artists have lived. Enjoy a gelato while shopping or simply wander the streets with the occasional breathtaking view over the cliffs to the seaside below.

October 17 Naples & Pompeii, Italy This morning dock in **Naples**, a dazzling city perched on a beautiful rock coast. Paul landed in the bay of Naples on his way to Rome. You may journey inland to ancient **Pompeii**, dating almost to the time of Paul where you can visit the spectacular ruins that were covered by ash from the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in A.D. 79. (Excursion on own.)

Dr. Paul L. Maier

Dr. Maier is The Russell H. Seibert Professor of Ancient History at Western Michigan University and a much-published author of both scholarly and popular works. His novels include two historical documentaries: *Pontius Pilate* and *The Flames of Rome*, as well as a theological thriller that became #1 national bestseller in religious fiction: *A Skeleton in God's Closet*. A sequel, *More Than a Skeleton*, appeared in 2003 and *The Constantine Codex* in 2011.

His non-fiction works include *In the Fullness of Time*, a book that correlates secular evidence from the ancient world impinging on Jesus and early Christianity; *Josephus - The Essential Works*, a new translation/commentary on writings of the first-century Jewish historian; and *Eusebius -- The Church History*, a similar book on the first Christian historian.

More than five million Maier books are now in print in twenty languages, as well as over 250 scholarly articles and reviews in professional journals.

Dr. Maier lectures widely, appears frequently in national radio, television, and newspaper interviews, and has received numerous awards. He has also penned seven children's books, and produced four four-hour video series dealing with Jesus, St. Paul, the early church, and current Christianity.
